

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Rehmat Welfare Foundation Jhelum is a well known NGO. It has been progressing by leaps and bounds since the establishment. It has earned many achievements in a very short period of time. It has the vision of " to assist and to provide healthcare facilities to the poor and down-trodden people". For this purpose, the foundation has launched many projects including free kidney dialyses, free OPD, fixation of water filtration plants, Free ambulance, distribution of food and money and to help the victims of natural disasters. All the projects are running by leaps and bounds due to generous donors specially the family of the founder and the chairman Mr. Abdul Rashid Mirza. The foundation has spent more than Rs. 300000000 (Three Hundred Million Rupees) on these projects and is planning for even more. All this is possible due to standardized management and administration, the generosity of the chairman and devotion of the governing body and the staff. Luckily, the foundation has got very loyal and kind-hearted personnel from top to bottom.

The foundation has benefitted thousands and has the plan to serve more than 1 million more in next 5 years. By spending more than Rs. 60000000. This would be done through extensive fundraising strategies and attracting more and more donors by adopting different techniques and by hiring field experts for each program and project. All the standards, policies, laws and regulations will be properly followed to avoid any hindrance in approaching the goals. Moreover, the logical and financial reviews and analyses, external evaluations and SWOT analyses will guide the management to decide in time and properly. The main focus will not only be on the treatment of the diseases but on nipping their roots from the bud as well. Fixation of water filtration plants is the example of it that is saving thousands of people from water-borne diseases.

Renal diseases cause thousands of deaths every year in Pakistan. The death of Mrs. Rehmat Karim was one of them that motivated her son Mr. Abdul Rashid Mirza to save others from these fatal diseases. For this purposes, he established a small dispensary in 2002 that started providing free medical aid to the poor and down-trodden people of the area. He donated his own house for this dispensary. Soon after the establishment of the dispensary, the number of the poor patients started growing day by day due to free and quality treatment. After few years of establishment of the dispensary, the number of the patients (mostly kidney patients) has increased so much that Mr. Abdul Rashid Mirza felt that the dispensary was not enough to serve so many patients. So he, with the help of his generous relatives, family members and friends including Tariq Mehmood, Shahid Aziz Majeedi, Tauqir Aslam, Muhammad Hanif Dar, Khalid Aziz Majeedi and Chaudhary Muhammad Sabir, founded Rehmat Welfare Foundation. In 2009, the foundation initiated the project of Rehmat Welfare Kidney Care & General Hospital that started free kidney dialysis and general OPD with treatment and medicines. The number of patients as well as the number of dialysis machines, doctors and other staff kept growing in parallel. This scenario proved that the poor and needy people of the area were in dire need of such center that could provide them free dialysis. So the foundation was given a proper structure and was duly registered as

Rehmat Welfare Foundation Jhelum in 03 April 2012. Due to the rapid increase in the number of kidney patients, the senior management of the foundation planned to nip the evil of renal diseases in the bud by providing clean and filtered water to the people of the area. For this purpose, the foundation conducted surveys and started fixation of water filtration plants in the most populous areas of the district where the water was contaminated and was causing kidney related as well as other fatal diseases. The first water filtration plant was fixed in Chowk Ahl-e-Hadees in December 2012 and until now, the foundation has fixed 21 filtration plants throughout the district that are providing clean and filtered water to thousands of people every day. The filters and the other machinery used in theses water filtration plants is of the best quality known globally. Besides the water filtration plants, the foundation also started providing clean drinking water to the students of government schools. More than 35 schools have been provided this facility until now. The reports of the surveys conducted by the government as well as the private institutions show that the provision of clean drinking water has significantly decreased the number of patients of kidney related and other water-borne diseases like hepatitis, typhoid, cholera, etc. Moreover, the foundation also initiated the project of general welfare in 2012. Under this project food (including flour, cooking oil, sugar, rice, etc.) is distributed among poor people of the area on every Eid and meat is distributed among hundreds of families on every Eid-ul-Adha. The foundation also organizes free medical camps in which thousands of patients are provided free treatment and medicines every year. It also conducts seminars, presentations and walks to spread awareness about kidney diseases. Doctors, government officials and people from all walks of life participate in these programs. The management of foundation always stands with the government as well as the public in natural disasters like flood and earthquake. The foundation has helped thousands of victims (throughout the country) of floods and earthquakes since 2012. All of the above mentioned efforts of the foundation has been recognized and appreciated by the government not only at district level but at provincial and national level also. The foundation was given "The Best NGO of the Province" award in 2014-15 by the Punjab government. There is a long list of other awards, prizes, certificates and appreciation letters which have been awarded to the foundation by government officials and departments.






